At 1719 we experienced a momentary interruption on **H 1106** impacting Candlestick Park. We are continuing to investigate this power interruption but currently it is unknown if the interruption was due to PG&E or Candlestick Park equipment. No public injuries or third party damage have been reported.

Operations Supervisor is currently leading an investigation into what exactly happened during the event and gathering data.

Restoration Supervisor has multiple Tmen and Cablemen investigating the field conditions at Candlestick Park on Jamestown Drive. These employees are being supported by SFPD and will remain on-site throughout the game (as planned) to support any needed response actions.

Substation Maintenance Supervisor is in direct contact with the Candlestick Park Lead Technician assessing the situation. We also have a PG&E Electrician on-site at the Park available to provide any mutual aid assistance that may be requested.

M&C Supervisor has both an underground and overhead crew already staged and available to support any needed repairs.

External Communications and ES&S are proactively providing information as needed on the details of this outage.

GovReI has already been in contact with City OES and the Mayor's Office.

Our next update will be provided once we have confirmed exactly what happened to cause this power interruption, San Francisco OEC remains open as planned.
