Dear Mr. Randolph:

Pacific Gas and Electric Company provides the enclosed summary sheet in compliance with California Public Utilities Code (PUC) section 2827.

Effective January 1, 2003, PUC section 2827(e)(1) requires that electric service providers notify the Commission if the processing of a request for establishment of net energy metering (NEM) service for solar or wind generators exceeds thirty (30) working days from the date the electric service provider receives the customer's completed application (including a signed interconnection agreement and final inspection clearance from the governmental authority with jurisdiction).

The enclosed summary sheets list solar and wind interconnection projects that meet these criteria for the third quarter of 2011 from July 1, 2011 through September 30, 2011. To protect customer confidentiality, a Project's ID number is used to identify projects. Also provided are: 1) the reason the interconnection has not yet been approved; and 2) the expected completion date.
