**Subject:** A11-07-008 Error in Scoping Memo Setting of Hearing Dates; Other Matters

Parties in A11-07-008:

It has come to my attention that the Scoping Memo scheduled evidentiary hearings for February 7 and February 8, in advance of the due date for rebuttal testimony. This is clearly in error and I will correct this via a ruling shortly. It is my belief that March 7 and 8 were the intended dates for hearings, but I will now need to determine if courtrooms and reporters are available.

In addition, I intend to rule shortly on the motion to dismiss of TURN.

As some of you know, I broke my arm and treatment has required two surgeries and necessary absences. With the shortage of ALJ's, it was not deemed practical to reassign this matter. Although my arm remains partly broken (and future surgery is possible), I am once again at work and will strive to make progress on all outstanding matters.
