Laura -- The few things I found on this are from a 2006 proceeding at the CPUC involving a statewide OIR on gas quality. Attached please find CPUC Decision 06-09-039 and PG&E's Advice Letter 2776-G implementing that Decision. PG&E proposed to make its Rule 21 tariff "more like" the other California utilities and that request also mentioned landfill gas. It appears that the restriction on landfill gas preceded this time period, however.

Hi Laura: Apparently, the legislature is yet again considering a bill that may be intended to allow landfill gas into utility pipeline systems.

A question has come up about when the utilities' tariff language that prohibits landfill gas (e.g. in PG&E Gas Rule 21) from being delivered into their pipelines was first adopted, and whether this was ordered in a CPUC decision. I don't think that was ordered in a CPUC decision. I think the landfill gas prohibition was likely proposed by the utilities in advice letters, probably in the early 1990s, after the CPUC adopted vinyl chloride limits. Would you please try to find out which PG&E advice letter first proposed the landfill gas prohibition? Thanks.
