It will help me to know what advice or directions CPUC already gave PG&E about the Senate Bill 705 (SB705).

Similarly, what directions/modified instructions has PG&E received about its upcoming NOI, as related to revised approaches, incorporating more explicit information about safety in the ratemaking process, etc.

Who has PG&E worked with on the above (name/division) -- I don't want to be at cross purposes from them

How does PG&E envision responding to the new requirements promulgated by SB705 and PU Code 961/963? (can you briefly describe how you understand/interpret SB705)

If PG&E had a deadline of June 29, 2012 to comply and transmit its Gas Safety Plan that meets SB705/PUCode 961/963, could it, please elaborate?

Other elements of the anticipated OIR Scope Expansion (preliminary, subject to finalizing and voting):

- A) CPUC will order both financial audits and management audits of every gas utility in California;
- B) Judge wants to explore/augment the Safety Certification (swearing to, like September 2011 decision) along the lines of code of ethics of Professional Engineers.
- C) Incorporates other legislation -- SB 44, SB 216, 56, and 8XX...

About GRCs or Gas Accords or other ratemaking proceedings:
