Mr. Malnight stated that a speedy decision on the 2013 bridge period is vital to the smooth functioning of energy efficiency programs. Ms. Berman stated that the Commission should consider adopting a procedure consistent with the June 30, 2011 Joint Parties Reply Comments to Administrative Law Judge's Ruling regarding 2013

Bridge Funding and Mechanics of Portfolio Extension, in order to assure continuation of existing programs without interruption. Mr. Dietz stated that the 2013 period should be considered a bridge and that changes in policy should be the focus of the next cycle. [Rule 8.4(c)]
