John Hughes, Director- Regulatory Relations, PG&E, initiated the communication with Sarah Thomas (Advisor to Commissioner Mark Ferron). [Rule 8.4(b)]

Mr. Hughes provided Ms. Thomas an update on the application. He stated that the CPUC approved a \$16.7 million cost estimate for the seismic studies in 2010 (by Decision No. 10-08-003). In September, 2011, PG&E filed a motion to reopen the application to approve additional funding for expanding the scope of the seismic studies. As a result PG&E is now requesting approximately \$64 million for the additional studies or an increase of \$47 million over the previously authorized amount. [Rule 8.4(c)]
