MOTION OF THE UTILITY REFORM NETWORK FOR PARTY STATUS

I. INTRODUCTION

Pursuant to Rule 1.4(a)(4) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, the Utility Reform Network ("TURN") hereby files this motion requesting party status in the above-referenced proceeding.

II. GROUNDS FOR PROPOSED INTERVENTION

A. Statement of interest

TURN is a non-profit consumer advocacy organization with a thirty year history of representing the interests of residential and small commercial customers before this Commission. TURN's articles of incorporation specifically authorize its representation of residential customers.

TURN's interest in this proceeding is to ensure that the alleged violations of state and federal pipeline safety rules and regulations are properly evaluated and adjudicated and appropriate remedies for such violations are assessed.

B. Statement of factual or legal contentions

TURN intends to be an active party to this proceeding. The extent of TURN's participation is not yet certain and will depend on the outcome of the staff's investigation.

TURN has not determined what factual or legal contentions it intends to make. However, our analyses and contentions will be limited to the scope established in the OII and in any subsequent scoping memo.
