Attached is the update you requested on the status of PG&E's negotiations with the biomass QFs. As a quick reminder, during our update in July we had executed 2 out of the 19 biomass QFs, and were still working to reach agreement with the remaining 17. To date we have executed price relief amendments with 12 facilities, and expect to

reach agreement with 6 of the remaining 7 facilities within the next several weeks.
