CALIFORNIA INDEPENDENT SYSTEM OPERATOR CORPORATION SUBMISSION OF SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION TO PROPOSAL

On January 13, 2012, the California Independent System Operator Corporation filed its proposal on the Phase 1 issues in this proceeding, in accordance with the Order Instituting Rulemaking (October 20, 2011) issued by the California Public Utilities Commission ("CPUC" or "Commission") and the Phase 1 Scoping Memo and Ruling of Assigned Commissioner and Administrative Law Judge (December 27, 2011). The ISO proposed that the Commission modify the resource adequacy program by adding a flexible capacity procurement requirement for the 2013 resource adequacy compliance year.

The ISO presented its proposal at the Energy Division workshop held on January 26-27, 2012. During the workshop, the ISO volunteered to follow-up on the discussion by answering the questions asked by the Energy Division and the parties, clarifying and explaining its proposal, and providing the additional information and data that had been requested. The attached Supplemental Information to Proposal contains the follow-up

information to the workshop the ISO agreed to provide about its proposed flexible capacity procurement requirement.
