The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) has called on Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) to provide shareholder funds for the CPUC to hire a set of independent consultants to review PG&E's safety and security proposals related to generation, the electric system, and the gas system as part of PG&E's 2014 General Rate Case. The CPUC is working on multiple fronts to implement recommendations made by an Independent Review Panel and the National Transportation Safety Board following the rupture of a PG&E pipeline in San Bruno, Calif., in 2010. As part of this effort, the CPUC began a stakeholder process to integrate safety and security more fully into the ratemaking process.
