This confirms that the Commission will actively supervise the negotiations ordered by the Commission in Resolution E-4471 between the Calpine Corporation and the three investor-owned utilities regarding the Sutter Energy Center, and clarifies that the effective date of the Resolution, for purposes of triggering the 30-day period in which to complete negotiations and submit a Tier 2 advice letter, is the date of publication, March 29, 2012.

The Commission's supervision of the contract negotiation processes will occur in several ways. As required by the Resolution, the IOUs will engage an independent evaluator for purposes of monitoring the negotiations on behalf of the Commission. As required by the Resolution, the independent evaluator will submit a report after the conclusion of the negotiations. Finally, the Commission will review the materials submitted by the independent evaluator along with the joint Tier 2 advice letter and make a determination as appropriate.
