Subject: Excavations related to T-47 on Line 153

Ben,

This is to confirm that we will proceed with examining 4 tie-in welds (2 performed by PG&E and 2 performed by PG&E's contractor), from two excavations approximately 1,700 feet apart, from Test T-47 performed in August of 2011. The excavations will be in the San Leandro area and examine 30-inch pipe of Line 153. The tie-in welds to be examined, along with existing pipe examined and included on H-Forms from the excavations, will need to be sand blasted for evaluation.

Based on our discussion, and depending on the outcome of PG&E's contacts and notifications to property owners in the vicinity of the excavations, I understand that we should be able to perform the excavation within two weeks, if not by sometime next week. Also, as we discussed, I request that PG&E provide CPSD with its listing of qualified radiograph vendors and their contact information. CPSD will select a vendor and notify PG&E so it can make arrangements to have CPSD's selected vendor perform the radiographs and evaluations during the excavations.

Please let us know of the outcome of PG&E's discussions with property owners and when you more specific timetables for performing the excavations discussed above. In the meantime, please let us know if you have any questions.
