I will get back to you on the proposal to require RA by 2020 that Sandy discussed on our call for RAM.

I wanted to raise one additional issue about the FiT PD that I forgot to mention. As PG&E is structuring its comments, it should be aware of the record for the proceeding. For instance, if PG&E wants to suggest a definitive price cap, it should cite evidence in the record for doing so, and for so calculating such a cap. As such, I might suggest that it would be more productive to submit comments that propose to adjust the existing framework that's provided for in the proposed decision already.
