PG&E objects to this data request on the grounds that it is outside the scope of this proceeding, and is not reasonably calculated to the discovery of admissible evidence. The "gas pipeline explosion in San Bruno" is not within the scope of this proceeding. Subject to and without waiving the foregoing objections, PG&E responds as follows:

PG&E has commissioned a survey to a sub-group of specific customers receiving notifications and communication regarding PG&E's Gas Pipeline Safety construction work impacting their neighborhood. The intent of these surveys is to understand the effectiveness of the communications regarding our construction activities and to inform future activities.

A total of 600 computer assisted telephone interviews were issued. Interviews were conducted between September 30 and October 9, 2011 Respondents were randomly selected from areas where pipeline segments were tested within the previous 30 day period and included Oakland, Brentwood, Mountain View, Sunnyvale, San Jose, San Leandro and Tehachapi.

Attachment GasPipelineSafetyOIR_DR_JointParties_001-Q07Atch01 provides the specific questionnaire utilized for this survey.

One key finding from this survey relates to ratepayer attitudes regarding safety. Ultimately, PG&E's customer outreach activities supporting Gas Pipeline Safety work improves the perception of safety among its customers. Other key survey findings were related to the effectiveness of our communications with impacted customers.
