Brian,

Thanks for your call back earlier. I returned your call shortly after, but you were on the other line.

I'm working on the following data request which I plan to issue to PG&E. I would like to discuss this with your before I make it official.

----

I would like for PG&E to identify locations in its service territory where there is a residence less than 200 feet from the base of a transmission tower. The attached table identifies each data point I am requesting and my preferred format.

I understand some elements of this data request may not be readily available or may present unique research challenges. Please let me know if and how you get hung up and we can work together to find an operable alternative. For example, if there are 10 homes that are within 200 feet of the transmission infrastructure, I am interested in an aggregated portrait of the situation AND the point of greatest proximity, but not an exhaustive list of every single point of proximity. Further, if data is readily available for points of proximity within 150 feet, but not 200 feet, the readily available data would probably suffice. In other words, don't get hung up on the fine print and work with me.

I hope this can be accomplished by April 17. Please let me know if you think more time is required.
