As I mentioned in my message, all years of the RA forecast are confidential for a period of three years after the date on which the forecast is made (Matrix Line II (A)(2)). The front three years of the forecast approach applies to other types of forecasted data, such as retail load (see Matrix Line V (B)). In that situation only the first three complete years of the forecast is kept confidential, but that does not apply to the RA forecast. Please let me know if you would like to discuss.
