Please note that certain attachments to this response contain sensitive personal information pertaining to current and former PG&Eemployees. For this reason, PG&Es providing this response pursuant to Public Utilities CodeSection 583. The dissemination of employee information contained in this response raises privacy concerns. As noted in prior data responses, whether an employee receives an LTIP award is discretionary, and is determined by his or her supervisor based on the employee's individual performance. Lat *Pards* generally must remain within guidelines approved by the CompensationCommittee, and LTIP awards granted to the CEO also must be approved by the independent members of the full Board of Directors of PG&EC orporation.
