NOTICE OF EX PARTE COMMUNICATION

Pursuant to Rule 8.4(a) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby gives notice of the following *ex parte* communications. The communications occurred on Wednesday, March 28, 2012, at approximately 2:00 p.m., 2:45 p.m., and 3:30 p.m. at the offices of the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) in San Francisco. Each communication was oral and no handouts were used. [Rule 8.4(a)]

Sidney Dietz, Director, Regulatory Relations, PG&E, initiated the three separate communications with Matthew Tisdale, Advisor to Commissioner Michel Florio; Scott Murtishaw, Advisor to Commission President Michael Peevey; and Rahmon Momoh, Advisor to Commissioner Timothy Simon (respectively). Also present at each of the three meetings was Steve Malnight, Vice President, Customer Energy Solutions, PG&E. [Rule 8.4(b)]

Mr. Dietz stated that PG&E filed its petition on March 19 because it had learned from its SmartMeter experience that customers resist PG&E and CPUC initiatives when they are not given a choice. Mr. Malnight stated that to support the goal of having as many customers as possible on dynamic rates, we need to communicate about rates as useful options for customers,

not just communicate that they must prepare because they won't have a choice about being defaulted to a mandatory TOU rate. Mr. Dietz stated that in the last ten years, customers have come to expect more choices, and businesses have learned to deliver those choices, and that utility rates are no exception. Mr. Malnight stated that in order for a choice to be communicated to customers, PG&E would like a decision by September. [Rule 8.4(c)].
