General Definitions

The "Unknown" customer category

Definition

The total number of Direct Access Service Requests (DASRs - including resubmissions and possible cancellations) received requesting sign-up with an Electric Service Provider (ESP), during the reporting period.

The total number of Direct Access Service Requests (DASRs) accepted requesting signup with an Electric Service Provider (ESP), during the reporting period.

The average number of business days, at the end of the required seven day period, between the time the DASR was received to the time it was determined to be accepted, rejected or pending.

The total number of complete Direct Access switches from UDC bundled service to Direct Access, during the reporting period.

The total number of complete Direct Access switches from one Electric Service Provider (ESP) to another Electric Service Provider (ESP), during the reporting period. (The table displays the count for the receiving ESP.)

The total number of complete Direct Access switches from Direct Access to UDC bundled service, during the reporting period.

The "Unknown" customer category exists to represent DASRs that are received by the UDC but may not be processed because of missing or incorrect DASR data which prevents the UDC from identifying the intended customer account and the correct customer class. In most of these cases, the UDC issues a "DASR Rejection" notice to the ESP, which includes the reason for rejection. The ESP may re-submit a corrected DASR at any time.
