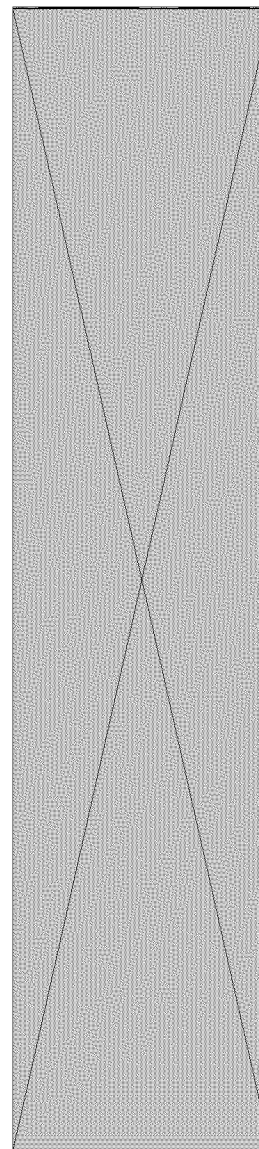
CPUC Affirms Citation and Fine Against PG&E

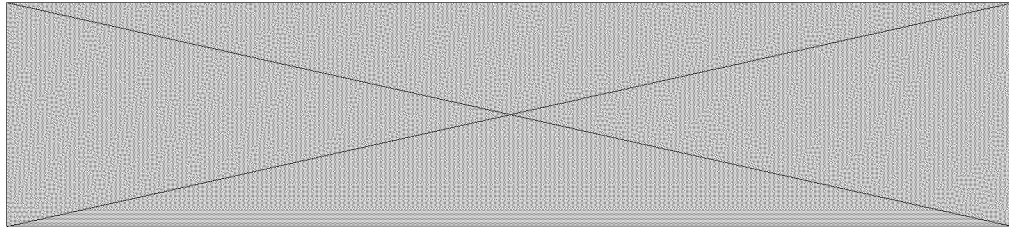
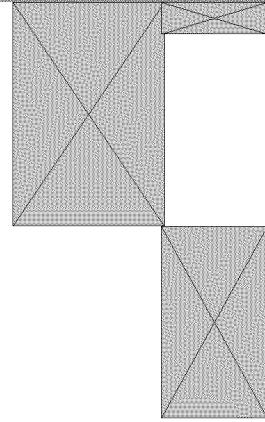
The CPUC has reaffirmed its staff directive that PG&E pay a citation of \$16.76 million for the utility's failure to conduct gas safety tests in Contra Costa County, and, separately, fined PG&E \$3 million for failure to comply with a CPUC pipeline records search. The fines are payable to the state's General Fund from PG&E shareholders.
