ADVICE LETTER 2358-E (U 902-M)

PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

SUBJECT: MODIFICATION TO SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COLLECTION NOTICE

San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) hereby submits for filing the following changes to its electric collection tariffs, as shown on the enclosed Attachment A.

DISCUSSION

SDG&E is modifying its collection notices to update information to reflect the initiation of remote disconnect functionality as provided in D.07-04-043, which approved a settlement among SDG&E, the Division of Ratepayer Advocates (DRA) and Utility Consumers' Action Network (UCAN) to allow for SDG&E's proposed Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) Project.¹

SDG&E has completed mass deployment of its AMI project and is nearing completion of its twelve month communication plan in accordance with the Disconnection OIR Settlement adopted in D.10-12-051. The Disconnection OIR Settlement requires SDG&E to "Implement a 12-month transition process during at least the first 12 months following the installation of each smart meter, whereby remote disconnections will not be allowed except if the customer initiates a termination of service request to the Utility."²

As a result, starting July 1, 2012, SDG&E may remotely disconnect customers for credit purposes.³ In support of this new functionality, changes to the attached electric service collection notice is deemed necessary to notify customers that disconnections may be performed remotely.

The current notice language begins as follows:

This is your final notification prior to disconnection. Your SDG&E amount must be received within 48 hours from the dates of this notice.

The proposed language is:

This is your final notice. You have 48 hours from the date of this notice to pay SDG&E or your service may be disconnected remotely.

The complete revised Collection Notice can be found in Attachment A.

PROTEST

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the California Public Utilities Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and must be received no later than May 29, 2012, which is 20 days of the date this Advice Letter was filed with the Commission. There is no restriction on who may file a protest. The address for mailing or delivering a protest to the Commission is:
