## <u>Re</u>: Withdrawal of Advice Letter 3864-E - Establishment of an Interim Interconnection Procedure for Rule 21 Qualifying Facilities Signing New PURPA Power Purchase Agreements With PG&E

In accordance with General Order 96-B, Section 5.3, Pacific Gas and Electric Company ("PG&E") hereby withdraws without prejudice Advice Letter 3864-E<sup>1</sup>, which was filed on June 17, 2011, seeking the California Public Utilities Commission's approval to modify PG&E's Electric Rule 21 to address the anticipated need for an updated interconnection procedure. The pending Rule 21 Interconnection Settlement and Rulemaking (R.) 11-09-011<sup>2</sup> (Order Instituting Rulemaking on the Commission's own motion to improve distribution level interconnection rules and regulations for certain classes of electric generators and electric storage resources) have obviated the need for this advice letter at this time.
