Hello everyone,
Corporate Security has received information that a protest may occur sometime Monday, May 14, 2012, at the General Office complex. The protesters are scheduled to be at the 77 Beale Street entrance location but may be at the 245 Market Street entrances. Corporate Security will work with local law enforcement, our security personnel, and building management to allow access to PG&E employees and those doing business with our company.

The blue barricades will be placed across the atrium at 77 Beale Street with each end left open for access. Security personnel will be posted at each opening to screen employees and those doing business with PG&E. All employees should be prepared to show their identification to enter the atrium or buildings. If it becomes necessary, we will close a building entrance and you will be directed the alternate entrance. Any questions should be directed to [Redacted] or Mike Peterson of Corporate Security.

Please **DO NOT** attempt to engage the protestors in conversation and/or debate their issues.
