In 2012, PG&E's PSEP program only plans to use two inspection companies for weld inspections, Canus and Tulsa Inspection Resources. Going forward, these contract inspectors will be using the same weld inspection form developed PG&E (Daily Field Weld Summary Report) when doing the visual weld inspections.

Please see the attached Contract Work Authorization for Tulsa Inspection Resources (TIR).

In 2011, PG&E had contractors supplement PG&E's workforce during the tie-in process working under PG&E supervision. The change contemplated this year is to have contractors conduct the entire tie-in process. The hydrotest team has identified about ten projects where contractors would conduct the tie-in process. These welds would be inspected by either Canus or TIR using the PG&E form. The first of ten tie-ins with the contractor conducting the tie-in process will likely occur in late July or early August.
