In accordance with the schedule set by Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Maribeth Bushey at the May 23, 2012 prehearing conference (PHC) in the above-captioned proceeding, Southwest Gas Corporation (SWGAs) and the Division of Ratepayer Advocates (DRA) hereby submit this report on the status of settlement discussions.

ALJ Bushey directed SWGAs and DRA to “meet and confer in an effort to reach an amicable settlement of the issues in this proceeding,” and to “file a status report on the settlement efforts” by today. (PHC – 2 Reporter’s Transcript 41:19-24.) SWGAs and DRA have had such discussions but at this juncture are not near agreement. SWGAs and
