Pursuant to Rule 16.1, the District hereby requests a rehearing on the issue of whether or not existing contracts should be included for the purposes of satisfying the new 750 MW cap implemented under the Final Decision issued on May 31, 2012. The District describes in its Motion to Open the Record and take Official Notice dated June 22, 2012 that inclusion of existing contracts¹ within the new FIT program is not consistent with the intent of legislation, and the practical implication of such an interpretation will have a potentially significant negative effect on the new FIT program. This Application relies on the District's motion as its basis, and is timely. The District respectfully requests an expeditious resolution of this matter.


Existing contracts means those within the existing FIT program, or those outside of the FIT program that will expire in coming months and could then participate in the program.
