QUESTION 2

What safety standards will PG&E propose for its gas pipeline work?

ANSWER 2

All labor by or for PG&E is done in conformance with all PG&E Gas Standards, U.S. DOT regulation 49 CFR Part 192, including DOT operator qualifications and drug and alcohol testing,, Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) and California OSHA (Cal-OSHA) requirements, and any federal, state and local laws, rules, regulations and ordinances. Job-specific Work Plans, Health & Safety Plans, and Environmental Safety Plans are required for performance of any work at PG&E by all PG&E employees and contractors.
