QUESTION 4

What will PG&E propose for ensuring that inspectors, X-ray providers, other jobsite observers and those administering worker-qualification tests will render their services with objectivity and independence from PG&E?

Answer 4

The interpretation of the radiographic films shall be evaluated by PG&E or a designated 3rd party NDT firm by Level II certified radiograph technicians (ANSI/ASNT CP-189) on the basis of API 1104, 18th Edition. PG&E conducts a visual and radiographic inspection on all welds according to PG&E Gas Standards, to ensure that the standard of acceptability for all welding equals or exceeds the requirements of API Standard 1104, 18th Edition, "A Standard for Field Welding of Pipelines." Radiographic summary reports are acquired by PG&E and placed in the job folder for the subject pipe segment for the life of the facility.
