**SUBJECT: VERIFICATION OF CLASSIFICATIONS**

**QUESTION 6**

1. What's the status of PG&E's correcting and verifying the classification of its pipeline segments?
2. Will PG&E's Implementation Plan verify the correct classification of all of its pipeline segments?

**ANSWER 6**

1. PG&E believes your question is referring to our pipeline class location study. PG&E filed a class location study report with the CPUC on June 30, 2011. The study is still in progress. 49 CFR Part 192.5 and 192.11 defines class location and pipeline design factor. As PG&E proceeds with work under the Implementation Plan, it will coordinate with the class location study effort to ensure that the correct classification of the pipeline segment is reflected in the Implementation Plan work scope.
