I spoke with Sunil yesterday about the South San Francisco and Colma replacement projects this summer. The South San Francisco project is on Mission Road and we hope to start that work in the field next week and complete most work by August 15. The Colma project is on Hillside Blvd and we expect to start that one in the second half of August. Both of these are on Line 132. [Redacted] is the lead project manager on these for PG&E.

Sunil has expressed interest in observing some of the work on the Colma project given its slight relocation and possible environmental concerns. Can you work with [Redacted] to keep Sunil up-to-date on the start and progress of that project? He or his staff may want to visit sometime in August/September.
