Afternoon Chris

Thanks for have that brief conversation yesterday afternoon. In spirit of follow-up I just wanted to send a brief note on the conclusions from our meeting yesterday. If you have any questions, please let me know.

- Redacted In March PG&E filed a \$20 Million CDA project pursuant to the Commissions directive in the Privacy Decision, for which we are currently in “informal” settlement discussion with key parties.
- Redacted Pursuant to the ALJ Ruling (Scoping Memo) PG&E and other parties on *Monday, July 30, 2012*, will file a report summarizing the outcome of these informal discussions.
 - PG&E will try and include some language into this report reflecting the fact that we are going to implement a demonstration pilot prior to the full scale CDA, and to the extent that changes to the CDA application are deemed necessary we file a motion with the Commission to modify our CDA Application.
- Redacted Following a conversation with the White House CTO, PG&E has decided to develop and implement a demonstration project in September this year, *over a period of six months*. This project will pilot key IT functionality, and will be rolled out as the 2nd iteration of PG&E GreenButton Connect platform that was launched in December last year. The purpose of this six month demonstration project is two-fold, to determine;
 - Whether the functionality that we have proposed in the CDA Application is optimal? If not, is there a better alternative to the current proposal
 - To the extent possible, what the potential demand would be for the CDA platform.
- Redacted PG&E will be funding the cost of this pilot project using *shareholder funds only*.
- Redacted Following the conclusion of the pilot project, PG&E will review the results and determine if and what modifications should be made to its CDA Application;
 - However, PG&E would like the Commission to stay on track with the review/approval of our CDA Application, and allow PG&E to file a motion for to modify our CDA Application, as appropriate upon conclusion of the pilot.
