Pursuant to Commission Rule of Practice and Procedure 11.6, this e-mail requests that the parties agree to a twelve (12) day extension for reply comments on the Feed-In Tariff (FIT) Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) and the separate utility tariffs implementing the FIT program adopted in D.12-05-035. Reply comments are currently due Wednesday, August 29.
