I have been out of the office since last Wednesday and am just now back at my desk. I will give you a call tomorrow in response to your voicemail on RAM. I have a separate question though – can you put me in touch with someone who would know detailed info about PG&E's E-SRG projects? In particular, I'm curious about the sub-500 kW Solar PV projects listed here: http://www.pge.com/includes/docs/word xls/b2b/energysupply/wholesaleelectricsuppliersolicita My questions: (1) Are these groundmount or rooftop solar projects? (2) I notice most of these are developed by Pristine Sun Fund – do you know if any of these projects are "daisy-chained"? (ie, they're essentially located on the same site) (3) I notice that of the sub-500 kW projects in the E-SRG database, only "existing" projects are online and delivering energy. None of these "new" solar PV projects are online – does PG&E think there are any viability issues with these projects coming online at this PPA price (~\$105/MWh)?

Let me know if you can track down someone who could answer these questions for me.
