This looks great. This matches all the tasks I have shown in my to do list. Here's a couple of extra tasks I have as well that we will be supplying to you:

1) Follow up on whether air quality APMs will further reduce impacts to less than significant and are voluntary, or do they reduce a significant impact to less than significant.

2) Research tree removal mitigation. Contact County of Santa Cruz and identify if they have any compensation or replanting requirements. We can do this task or Panorama can complete. Just let me know how you would like to tackle this.

3) Cultural Resources Report Addendum to include the additional work spaces. This will fold into your #2 data request.

4) A new pole count table as shown in the PEA Table 2-1. If you would like, we can complete this or Panorama.

We hope to have this data to you in the next 30 days if that works for the schedule. If you need it sooner, please let me know.

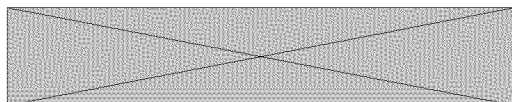
