Redacted would like the Calif PUC to chose Option A for E-4521. Bottle Rock Power sits on property that my Greatgrand Father homesteaded. We have the property east of the the power plant. Our Aunts and Uncles still own the property the power plant is on. This has been a failed venture from day one. DWR forced a water bond on the Metropolitan Water District of Southern Calif to pay for Bottle Rock the first time. They will still be paying for this bond up to 2024. The price will be in excess of 400 million by that time. Bottle Rock Power LLC is into this project between 350 to 400 million and they have not started on the
