Hello. As follow-up to outreach from the Recurrent team(9/13), do you have time to meet this week to discuss WSF's request for site change in order to mitigate a California Farm Bureau Federation (CFBF) lawsuit?

At our meeting, I would like to:

- Share with you my recent (9/21) constructive conversation with Gary.
- Ask for your thoughts regarding my attached letter to Fong –*WSF Findings and Request v2*. Specifically, if the CPUC feels that PG&E's site switch allowance for the UOG projects and denial of WSF's site switch request is 'fair and consistent' treatment per D. 09-06-050 Rulemaking 08-08-009 considering that both projects sought site change as the result of CFBF pressure related to Williamson Act land in Fresno County and this site change request occurred after winners were selected for both programs.

“Finally, the decision clarifies that the review by utilities and by Energy Division of contracts negotiated outside the context of an annual RPS solicitation (bilateral contracts) should apply the same standards as are applied to the review of contracts that are the result of a solicitation”.

- Ask your opinion on how best to proceed to resolve this professionally and quickly.

Thanks very much for all your assistance to date. Specifically, you help with Resource Adequacy was instrumental in helping PG&E and WSF design a workable solution for both parties.

We greatly appreciate the opportunity to discuss these matters with you. I believe this is the last remaining hurdle to get this project into construction.
