Attached please find PG&E's response to Energy Division's Data Request regarding the Tehachapi Renewable Transmission Project (TRTP).

Please find some notes below about PG&E's approach in responding to this request:

- PG&E has included projects based on the criteria provided in the data request and other available criteria, such as developer monthly progress reports and geographical location. PG&E has included projects that it believes could be impacted by TRTP, even it has not confirmed that all projects will be directly impacted.
- PG&E gathered the status of the TRTP segments (columns N-P of the attached spreadsheet) through phone conversations with Southern California Edison (SCE). The responses in these columns represent the information as communicated by SCE.
- For some projects that are not yet executed, PG&E has not yet begun conducting monthly progress report conference calls with the developers, so PG&E has less information on the status of the interconnection process for these projects. Some information is listed as "Unknown" or "TBD".
