This note is provided for your information. An Unusual Event (UE) was declared for Units 1 and 2 at 12:09 a.m. (0009) on Sunday, Oct. 21 after slight movement was felt in the Control Room following a 5.3 magnitude earthquake that occurred outside of King City (approximately 90 miles from the plant).

Both Units remain stable and are operating at 100 percent power. DCPP personnel continue to closely monitor the plant and we will inform you once we exit the UE. In an effort to continue to keep our community informed, a media release will also be issued once the event has been successfully exited.

We will be communicating to plant employees in a similar fashion.
