Correction and change of recommendation. As I just told Hyun, it's vital that y and Hyun call [Redact] directly today to invite the prosecution into the mediation process. Do NOT rely on any intermediary to make this communication for you. You are welcome to include your outside defense counsel on such a call, but make the call yourselves.

It also is urgent, in my view, that you do this ASAP.

Ideally, you should arrange to go over to [Redact] office this afternoon and speak to her in person about this. Again, you can feel free to bring your outside defense counsel along, but you and Hyun should go yourselves -- and even Tony if you can persuade him to do so.

Also, please send me Hyun's email address, so I can copy him on my messages. I don't have his address here with me, and I do want to keep in in the loop on these communications.
