Dear Mr. Allen,

Thank you for your cooperation during my visit to the Kern Power Plant yesterday.

CPSD requests that PG&E:

- 1. Provide a root analysis for this incident, including recommended corrective actions.
- 2. Provide an electronic copy of the two videos of the demolition that you showed yesterday.
- 3. Not resume demolition of the oil tanks, or begin demolition of the boiler, until CPSD has reviewed this root cause analysis.
- 4. Preserve evidence required to conduct a thorough root cause analysis, including the man-lift involved in the accident.
- 5. Provide a root cause analysis for the Hunters Point power plant demolition incident on January 28, 2008.

At the end of the site visit, you mentioned that Cal/OSHA approved removal of the man-lift that was involved in the incident. Because the man-lift will be part of the root cause analysis investigation, please do not remove the man-lift until the root cause analysis is complete and has been reviewed by CPSD.

CPSD will request additional documents next week.
