Hi Brian - I hope you're well. As you know I'm back in Legal Division and have a small matter I'd like to talk to one of your lawyers about.

My client in Consumer Protection and Safety Division, Janeen Long, has asked me to follow up with PG&E regarding some Energy Efficiency funds that may not have been properly handled by PG&E's contractor, Enalasy. I'm trying to deal with the person in PG&E Legal who would handle this matter, so that we deal with matters on a lawyer-to-lawyer basis.

In the attached letter, PG&E Mass Market Energy Solutions and Services Director Duane Larson contacted Enalasy, one of PG&E's EE verification contractors, about EE ratepayer funding for EE rebates that PG&E paid out to Enalasy, but that Enalasy allegedly did not pay over to subcontractors. PG&E has been in contact with Enalasy several other times in 2012, but I'm trying to determine where the matter stands now.

My client in CPSD has dealt with an EE program manager, [Redacted] [Redacted] and I understand that Energy Division's [Redacted] has also been in contact with PG&E on the matter.

Can you help put me in contact with the right person in PG&E Legal? Thanks!
