Instead, the project will be taken over by CNSE/PVMC in New York <u>http://www.uspvmc.org/</u>. They are completing their due diligence and hope to sign in the next few days. CNSE will move the project to Albany and the State of New York will be contributing funding to the project. They mentioned that New York has invested \$14B into semiconductors and has set aside more funding for green energy.
