Hurricane Sandy DOE Situation Report # 10

1000 EDT, November 2, 2012

Restoration efforts still continue in 11 states for customers without power. The 10th situation report, provided by the Energy Department's Office of Electricity Delivery and Energy Reliability, highlights restoration estimates and efforts by electric utilities. As of 9:00 am EDT November 2, there are 3,628,739 customers without power in the affected States. This is a decrease of 825,911 customers without power since the 9th Situation Report.
