Clean Coalition supports an extension for the regulatory delay category and suggests a day-for-day extension for administrative cause for up to eighteen (18) months when the Seller has taken all commercially reasonable actions and met all its requirements and deadlines in seeking to obtain permit approval and interconnection agreements.
