RE: PG&E's Request for Extension of Time to Comply with Rate Design Window Schedule

Dear Ms. Slocum:

By letter dated November 21, 2012, you requested on behalf of Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) a one-week extension in the schedule for filing PG&E's 2013 Rate Design Window (RDW) Application, extending the due date from Monday, November 26, 2012 to Monday, December 3, 2012.

You explain that the sole purpose of PG&E's 2013 RDW is to provide the Commission and interested parties with a cost study (Study) required in Decision 11-12-053 relating to demand charges for large commercial and industrial customers with intermittent loads, including those that have solar installations. You further explain that in making final preparation of the Study, PG&E is awaiting a final review of the results by its Distribution Planning operating unit, which is not likely to occur in time for a November 26th filing. PG&E's request for an additional week is to allow for the necessary quality control review to be completed.

I find that your request for the extension of time is reasonable. Accordingly, I hereby grant your request, authorizing the requested one-week extension until December 3, 2012 for PG&E to file its RDW application. Pursuant to Rule 16.6 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, please serve a copy of this letter on all parties to Application 10-03-014. Also, Rule 16.6 requires that requests for extension be received by the Executive Director at least three

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business days before the existing date for compliance. Your letter fails to meet this deadline. I expect compliance with this rule in the future.
