Dear Judge Vieth:

The parties have met several times in different configurations and most parties participated in a telephone conference yesterday morning. TURN and CPSD have reached an agreement on the investigation with PG&E, but need to work out some final details. We believe that we can have a motion proposing the settlement on file very soon. Some other parties have indicated a desire to continue with discovery, and in order to accommodate that, the settling parties have agreed to hold filing the motion until November 16, 2012, subject of course to your approval.

Thus, the suggested procedural schedule by PG&E, TURN and CPSD is that a motion proposing the settlement be filed by November 16 with the other dates determined by the Rules and the Court's calendar.
