2. Reporting in WREGIS –expansion retirement subaccounts:
 - YYYY CA RPS PCC1 CBA - for REC's from a facility interconnected to a CBA
 - YYYY CA RPS PCC1 DT - for REC's that were Dynamically Transferred
 - YYYY CA RPS PCC1 S - for REC's that were within the schedule
 - YYYY CA RPS HIS-POU - for POU Historic Carryover REC's
 - YYYY CA NO RPS - for REC's retired but not applied to CA RPS

 - a. Up to 36 Months after electricity generation to retire and then report REC's
 - b. Procurement must not be claimed before the contract execution date
