CPUC REDUCES COST OF CAPITAL FOR STATE'S UTILITIES

SAN FRANCISCO, December 20, 2012 - The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) today established a reduction in the 2013 return on common equity (ROE) and return on rate base (ROR) for and Southern California Edison (SCE), San Diego Gas & Electric (SDG&E), Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) and Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E).

The 2013 authorized ROE, ROR, and resulting revenue requirement reduction is as follows:

This reduction in revenue requirement is estimated to reduce the utility's average residential customer's monthly bill as follows:

Said Commissioner Mark J. Ferron, "Our utilities need to raise substantial amounts of capital at the same time that there is a huge need for investment in energy infrastructure across the country. Our decision today sets a return on equity that is fair and reasonable, and sends a clear signal to the market to invest in California."
