NOTICE OF EX PARTE COMMUNICATION

Pursuant to Rule 8.4(a) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby gives notice of the following ex parte communication. The communication occurred on Thursday, December 6, 2012, at approximately 11:15 am, at the offices of the California Public Utilities Commission in San Francisco. The communication was oral, and included a handout, which is attached to this notice. [Rule 8.4(a)(c)]

Sidney Dietz, Director, Regulatory Relations, PG&E, initiated the communication with Bishu Chatterjee, Advisor to Commissioner Timothy Simon. Also present was Jana Corey, Director of Policy & Integrated Planning in Customer Energy Solutions. [Rule 8.4(b)]

Mr. Dietz stated that while PG&E continues to support a savings-based incentive for EE performance, PG&E believes that the Alternate Proposed Decision (APD) is a reasonable alternative given the timing. Ms. Corey stated that the incentive in the APD is in line with incentives in the past and supports the CPUC's goals of providing predictable incentives for EE. Ms. Corey further stated that the APD recognizes the

importance of incentives and provides the appropriate support for Commission policy of placing energy efficiency highest in the loading order. [Rule 8.4(c)]
